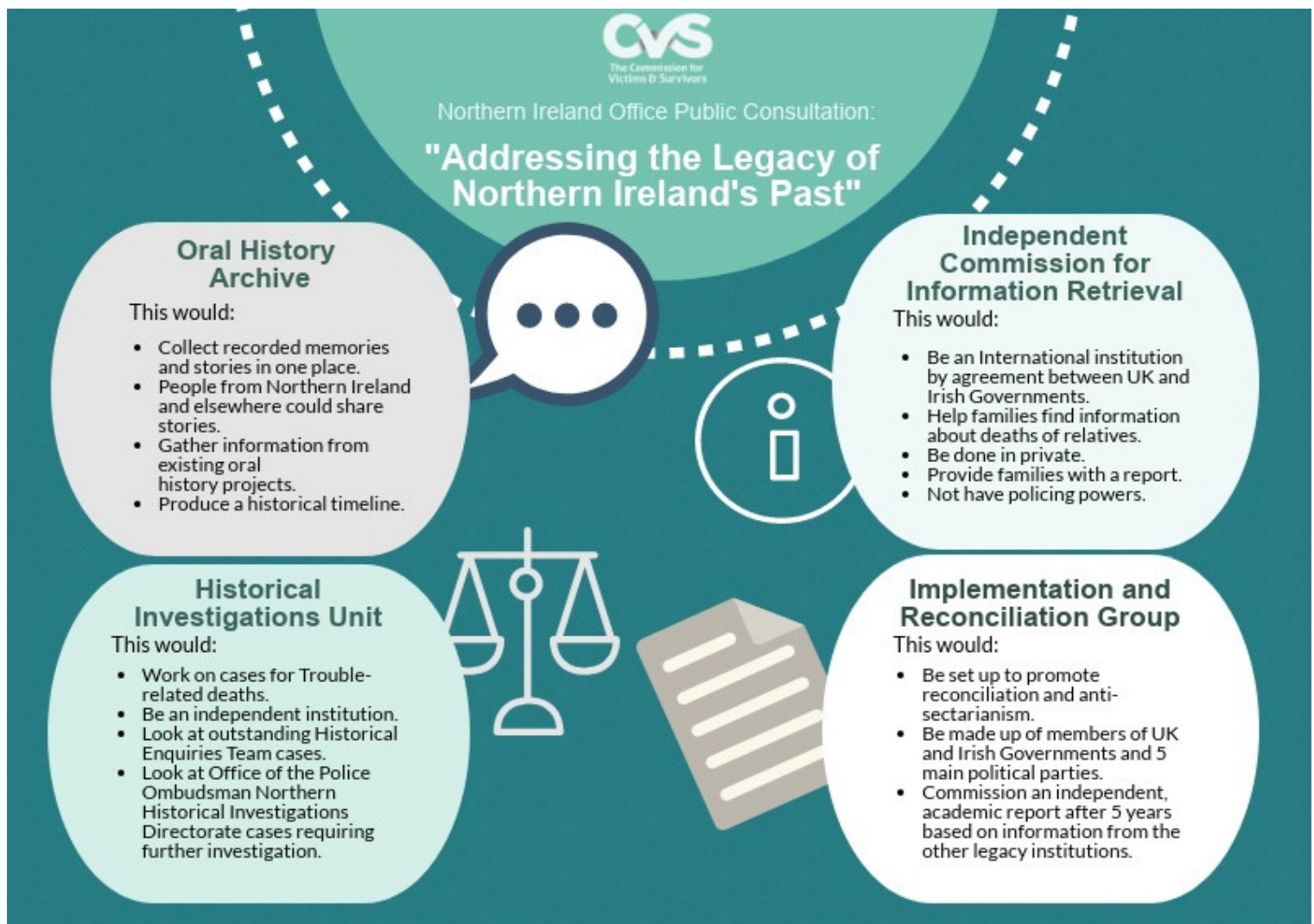

# The Aim of the Consultation

A Consultation is a process where the public are given the opportunity to give their opinions on legislation the government is going to deliver.

This consultation is on proposed agencies to help deal with the legacy of the past in Northern Ireland.

It includes draft legislation that will go through Westminster.

The Commission for Victims and Survivors will be hosting closed-**group information sessions** throughout August 2018 to help you understand the proposals outlined in the consultation.

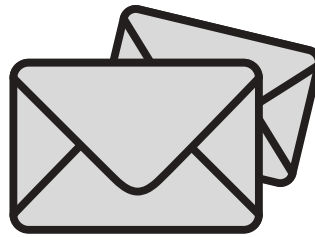
We will also encourage your feedback and provide guidance on how you can have your say by submitting an individual response.

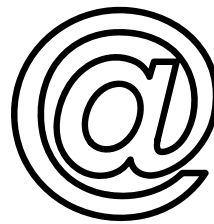
